Hope 24/7 is an accredited non-for-profit charitable organization located in Brampton. Our mission is to be the Centre of Excellence for clinical intervention and the prevention of relationship and sexual violence. Our organization provides a range of services and programs for persons twelve years of age or older who have experienced trauma. Hope 24/7 is also the designated Sexual Assault Centre for the Region of Peel. Hope 24/7 is a pro-choice, feminist organization.

Our Board of Directors is a team of individuals with a broad range of knowledge, skills and perspectives. Although applications from interested and qualified potential candidates from the health, social services and educational sectors are welcome, we are particularly interested at this time in individuals with experience in Finance (CPA or CFO), Human Resources and Fundraising/Fund Development. Candidates from the Region of Peel are preferred. Prior board leadership experience is an asset.

The governing team is looking for dynamic, community-driven candidates who are solution-based thinkers with the ability to provide strategic direction towards:

- providing access to services closer to clients, ensuring client satisfaction and client advocacy
- deriving new ways to engage with clients, families, and partners
- enhancing the client service experience
- maintaining and/or improving service quality based on historic strategies and metrics.

Expectations of prospective candidates to the Board of Directors of Hope 24/7 include:

- endorsing the mission and values of the organization, as well as its Statement of Positions;
- ability to attend and be prepared for quarterly meetings held the third Monday evening of the month and the Annual General Meeting (held in September) in Brampton;
- attending a minimum of seventy percent (70%) of regularly scheduled board meetings;
- participating on a minimum of one (1) board committee;

- attending a board orientation session and complete a review of the governing documents of Hope 24/7;
- obtaining a Police Reference Check for the Vulnerable Sector;
- agreeing to sign a Declaration of Conflict of Interest, Confidentiality Agreement, and Statement of Positions; and
- supporting and participating in the fundraising activities of Hope 24/7.

Interested candidates for the Board of Directors are requested to send a cover letter and resume in one document. The cover letter should outline why you are interested in joining the Board of Directors and what you will offer the organization.

Appointments range in length from one to three years.
