

## Summer Student Psychotherapist-in-Training Opportunity Hope 24/7

At Hope 24/7, we have shape how people see themselves for the better. Transformation, excellence and compassion is our business.

Hope 24/7 has received funding through the Canada Summer Jobs Program to support a psychotherapist-in-training. This is an outstanding opportunity for an **under-employed, regulated health professional** to receive intensive training on dealing psychotherapy in a trauma environment. The opportunity spans approximately 8 weeks.

Hope 24/7 is an accredited Community Health Provider, operating the Centre of Excellence for clinical intervention and the prevention of relationship and sexual violence. As a trauma centre, we work with all persons 12 years of age and older, using evidence-based interventions. Hope 24/7 operates under trauma-informed and harm-reduction frameworks.

Hope 24/7 is a pro-choice, feminist organization. Candidates must operate within the Agency's Statement of Positions, found on our website.

We will be screening on a rolling basis until the position is filled. Target hiring is June 2019.

What are we specifically looking for from you?

- Two (2) year Graduate Degree from a recognized university in a related field (e.g. Social Work, Psychology, Sexuality, Marriage and Family Studies, Occupational Therapy, Counselling Psychology).
- Member in good standing with a **regulated professional college** including, but not limited to, the College of Social Workers, College of Registered Psychotherapists of Ontario, College of Psychologists and College of Occupational Therapists.
- Must work in alignment with the Agency's Position Statements.
- Knowledge of applicable legislation and professional standards.
- Knowledge of diagnostic criteria set out in the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual (DSM).
- Strong written and verbal communication skills.
- Strong and well-developed interpersonal skills.
- Proficiency in the use of computer technology, internet and email fundamentals, databases, and working knowledge of Apple software programs including Pages, Numbers and Keynote.

- Ability to work independently and as a team member to achieve outcomes and meet deadlines.
- Ability to balance demands and priorities and to manage effectively.
- Use professional judgment within established guidelines.
- Accommodate competing demands.
- Articulate and integrate the values of Hope 24/7.
- Value and honour diversity and the richness it brings to a community.
- Foster trust through open dialogue.
- Identify issues, gather and process relevant information, explore solutions and implement the most appropriate response.
- Demonstrated good judgment to:
  - maintain control in difficult and situations;
